Eben's Essentials

One reason why people suffer is because some of us violate law and order. God created a world ruled by natural laws. They were established at the Creation to benefit humans. It takes intelligence to bring about order in our material world. Only God could do that.

We all know that if these laws are challenged, then we will suffer the consequences. If a man steps off the roof of his house, gravity will pull him to the ground below. If a child steps in front of a moving truck, since two objects cannot occupy the same space at the same time, the truck will hit the child and cause him harm. The natural laws that God created allow humans to constructively produce fire to cook food. But the same laws that allow food to be cooked can also allow destructive events such as forest fires. Laws regulate all of nature—not just the parts we find convenient. The result is order not chaos.

In Luke 13:2-5, Jesus told the story of some men who died when the tower of Siloam collapsed. Did these men perish because of their sin? No, they died because a natural law was operative. Natural laws work regularly so we can understand them and benefit from them. They are not haphazard and capricious.
