Richard's Reflections

Welcome and Happy Easter!

We are very grateful for the presence of everyone today. To those of you who are guests to Westwood - we are honored and blessed that you chose to come and worship with us today. I hope you'll stay for Sunday School and also give us a chance to meet you.

We believe, as you do, the Resurrection of Jesus is a life-giving and life-changing event. But have you ever wondered what it was like for those who came that day to the tomb? They came for a special purpose, to anoint the body of Jesus (you see they really believed He would still be in the tomb). But as the angel said, "*He is not here; for He is risen.*" Notice with me how Jesus' resurrection affected them and how it can affect us some 2,000 years later.

IT CALMED FEARS (Matthew 28:5) - Notice the first words the angel spoke, "*Do not be afraid.*" It was a frightening time. Yet, as is always the case when His children are fearful, the Lord speaks words of peace. Many of us have a heart of jumbled nerves. And that message should be like good medicine to our soul today. He has conquered the sin, death and the grave...that's good news!

IT CAUSED HOPES TO SOAR (Matthew 28:7) - "*And indeed He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him.*" Can you imagine the high hopes the disciples had at the prospect of seeing Jesus again....ALIVE? Friends, Christians have this same hope. He has gone before us into heaven and there we shall see Him again, just as He has promised (John 14:1-3).

Eben's Essentials

One of the most diabolical factors of an addiction is the tendency for it to give less and less satisfaction as it progresses, while the addict has to consume more and more of the product or activity. In other words, the person gets less for more. The law of diminishing returns is at work.

This principle is true in common life. When we let the thrill go and die away, then we may find new thrills and excitement along the way. But if we decide to make a regular diet of thrills and sensations, trying to prolong them indefinitely, we may find them growing weaker and fewer. The result might be a life of boredom and disillusionment.

C.S. Lewis says that it is just the people who are ready to submit to the loss of a thrill and settle down to the sober interest, who are then most likely to meet new interests and thrills in a different direction. For example, the person who has been consumed by music may find a new passion in woodworking, etc.

This may be one small part of what Jesus meant when He said that a thing would not really live unless it first dies (John 12:24,25).
