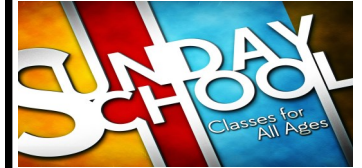

Richard's Reflections

Forgiveness

Larry and Marianne have been having problems in their marriage of 17 years. She finally left him. "It was a culmination of things," he said. "But I am desperately trying to save our marriage." Marianne left their home in Orlando, Florida, and went to her parents' home in Jacksonville. She changed her cell phone number so he couldn't reach her. Her parents have blocked him from entering their gated community. So he sent her five dozen roses. His goal was just to communicate. To ask forgiveness. To plead for the chance for the two of them to work on their relationship. Lacking any response from his estranged wife, Larry took out a full-page ad in the Florida Times-Union. "*I can only hope you will give me the chance to prove my unending love for you. Life without you is empty and meaningless.*" The cost of a full-page ad means that Larry sent Marianne a \$17,000 apology.

Jesus said that we are to forgive anyone who sins against us and asks for our forgiveness (Lk. 17:3-4). Refusing to forgive is really not an option if we expect to be forgiven ourselves (Matt. 6:14-15). The Christian is called to imitate God. That means, among other things, that we are to forgive others just as God has forgiven us (Eph. 4:32). As a practical matter, only those who know their own need of forgiveness usually find the grace to forgive others who wrong them. In the same way, the ability to forgive others is strong evidence that the person forgiving has experienced the grace of forgiveness by God. There can truly be no price put on the blessing of forgiveness.

Eben's Essentials

Notice the contrast: The world says, "If it feels good, do it." God says, "Do good even when it feels bad." Most of the time our five senses give us fairly accurate information. We enjoy a cool drink, the taste of ice cream and the fragrant scent of a flower. But our senses are only part of the information we need to be safe. Ask the allergic person about the scent of a flower, the diabetic about ice cream, or the individual with a cold drink on a freezing day about its effect. Or go deeper and ask the recovering alcoholic or drug addict about whether feelings are reliable guides.

Using pleasure as a guide to whether something should be done is not always helpful. For example, in the areas of marriage and extra-marital sex, following pleasure as our main guide can lead to destroyed relationships and lives. Doing what is right may require something inconvenient or costly, but the ultimate result will be a sense of profound satisfaction (i.e., pleasure).

The Psalmist understood this principle when he told God's people "Turn from evil and do good; then you will dwell in the land forever" (Ps. 37:27).
