# Richard's Reflections

## ***It Takes ALL of Us!***

Sometimes Christians refer to themselves as, "just a member". The fact is all who have trusted in Jesus as their Savior and have been immersed into a relationship with Him are members. But we are all integral parts of the church. Paul makes this clear when he wrote, "*For in fact the body is not one member but many*" (1 Corinthians 12:14). Let's note a few things from Paul that will let us know that if our church is to grow and flourish IT TAKES ALL OF US!

**I. Every Member is SPECIAL** - From verse 15 to verse 18 Paul discusses the similarity between the physical body and the spiritual body, the church. He plainly teaches that not everyone can be a hand or foot or eye. We also need ears and noses and arms. Every member of the body is special and important. YOU are important to the cause of Christ. When you read Romans 16:3-15 you will find a list of people who, though not as well-known as Moses or Peter, were certainly important ingredients in the growing of the church in Paul's time.

**II. Every Member is to SERVE** - As Paul continues his comparisons he says, "*If the whole body were an eye, where would be the hearing*" (12:17). This indicates action on the part of the members of the body. They serve useful purposes. So too it is with us as Christians. We are, as Paul wrote in Ephesians 2:10, "*...His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.*" Not serving to be saved, but serving because we are saved (Ephesians 2:8-9).

**III. Every Member is to SHARE** - "*the members should have the same care one for another*" (12:25b). We as the body of Christ are not to be "an island to ourselves". We are to be involved with each other. Loving one another (1 John 4:20) and caring for each other (Galatians 6:2).

There are many things we want and need to accomplish here at Westwood for Christ - **and some of us need to realize it takes ALL OF US!!**
