## Richard's Reflections

*"Do all things without complaining or arguing"*

*(Philippians 2:14).*

That's a tough one, right? For some of us it seems like an impossibility - some of us just complain about everything. It's become part of our nature. There's several dangers in allowing ourselves to be constant and consistent complainers.

1. God said clearly, "**DO NOT COMPLAIN!**" Is His directive any less plain than when He says, "Do Not Murder?" or "Do not Steal", etc.? If God says for us not to do it, it makes it a sin when we do, right?
2. Complaining hurts our witness for Christ. No one wants to be around a complainer. When you constantly complain people will start avoiding you like the plague. So how are you ever going to win people to Christ, if people never want to be around you? Jesus tells us in **Matthew 5** that we are to be lights in the world—but the complainer is extinguishing his/her light with every complaint.
3. Paul tells us we shouldn't complain "*so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe...*" (Phil. 2:15).

If you are a complainer, God's word says **STOP!** Try finding the good in things instead of always seeing the bad (or at least your perception of bad). Try complementing or encouraging someone instead of complaining to them. Trust me if you are a constant complainer - that is not a gift from God! Pray and ask God to remove it from your life!
