The great thinker and writer, C.S. Lewis, had a way of presenting profound ideas with such clarity they seemed almost obvious. As an example, take his comments on Christ's statement in Matt. 5:4-8, "Be perfect, therefore, as your Heavenly Father is perfect." Lewis, in *Mere Christianity*, sheds light on Christ's saying by pointing out that if we let Him, Jesus will make us perfect. But if we choose to allow it, no matter what it cost Him on the Cross, and no matter what it costs us in our life, He will not rest until it is accomplished.
