## Eben's Essentials

We all know repentance is an essential element in the Christian faith. But do we realize that repentance is not so much a feeling as it is a moral virtue? We are responsible for it. We are to be in control of it. Repentance is commanded, but it is less feasible to command a feeling. We can be in control of the choices of our will, but not so much of our emotions and feelings. Repentance is the choice of the will.

The test of whether we have repented or not is relatively straightforward. Do we choose to change, to make amends, to undo our wrongs? For example, if the sin is lust, do we do away with every form of pornography we have? If the sin is adultery, do we break with and say no to the illicit other person? If not, the authenticity of our repentance is in serious doubt. We may fail and fall again after sincere repentance, but if we are truly repenting, we must choose the right intention before we succeed or fail.

Paul, in speaking to the Athenians, said, "And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men everywhere to repent (Acts 17:30).
