Eben's Essentials

In Matthew 18:2-3, Jesus said that citizens of the Kingdom of Heaven are to be like little children. He said that these kinds of folks are considered great in the eyes of God. Most of us recognize there are some characteristics common to children not to be emulated. Immaturity and pettiness come to mind. But evidently there are traits of children Christians are to try to copy.

The theme of the first part of Matthew 18 appears to be humility. Children depend on others and must live by faith that responsible adults will take care of them. True Christians must depend on their Heavenly Father. An unspoiled child accepts his position in life, enjoys it, and does not try to act like someone older. Psalm 131 states that a childlike spirit does not get involved with things too great or too difficult but calms and quietens itself like a child with its parents.

As the 18th chapter of Matthew progresses, the emphasis shifts to the way children (including children in the faith) are to be treated. In humility, do we receive novices in the faith or despise them?

To put it simply, humility generates obedience; a lack of humility generates disobediences.
