Life Group Questions

Sunday April 16, 2017

- Take a few minutes and read together the Resurrection accounts found in: **Matthew 28:1-10; Mark 16:1-8; Luke 24:1-12; John 20:1-18.**
1. What thoughts, feelings and emotions did you feel this morning as we discussed the Resurrection of Jesus and even now as you've read together the above passages?
 2. What ultimate "*proof*" would the Resurrection of Jesus provide to those who seek Him? (**John 2:13-22**).
 3. How does the Resurrection of Christ empower verses like John 14:6? Discuss the truths Jesus taught in this passage.
 4. Read **John 10:17-18**. Discuss the amazing combination of humility and power Jesus displays in these verses. Note these same qualities also in **Philippians 2:5-8**.
 5. Notice what the angel said to the women in **Matthew 27:5**: "*Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said.*" Jesus promised he would rise from the dead...and he did. Now why would we ever doubt his ability to keep any of the promise he has made to us?
 6. Consider the three promises we mentioned this morning:
 - The Promise of a Forgiven Past (**Colossians 2:13; Romans 8:1**)
 - The Promise of Strength to Manage Problems (**Ephesians 1:20; Philippians 4:13**)
 - The Promise of a Secure Future (**John 10:28-30; Romans 8:38-39; Jude 1:24; John 17:3**)
