***Sunday September 10, 2017***

1. Have you ever evaluated or rated a church worship service? What is the main problem with such a perspective? (Psalm 29:2; Revelation 14:7)
2. Describe your thoughts on both ingredients in genuine worship: a sense of awe (Isaiah 6:1-5; Psalm 8:3-9) and a sense of joy (Acts 2:43; 46-47; Psalm 100).
3. How should the knowledge that God is present in our assemblies affect our personal worship each Sunday? (Matthew 18:20).
4. Our worship should always have an element of thanksgiving to God. For what might we thank Him?
5. If worship moves me to be convicted of my own sinfulness like Isaiah (Isaiah 6:5), what must worship also naturally include? (Isaiah 6:6-7; 1 John 1:7)
6. Isaiah was moved by worship. What did it cause him to do? (Isaiah 6:8). What should worship today cause us to do?
7. How can we, according to 1 Corinthians 14:25 and Acts 2:47, evangelize people through our corporate worship assemblies?
