1. Who is your favorite character in Hebrews 11? Why?
2. Didn't Jesus trust God in the garden? (Matthew 26:36-46) But he wasn't "delivered" right away was he? What did he have to endure before his deliverance?
3. How do we reconcile in our minds (and with God's word) the fact that some people we pray for are healed and others for whom we pray just as fervently are not, and now have gone on to their reward?
4. What is the constant in the stories of Job (13:15) and Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego (Daniel 3:17-18)
5. Read Proverbs 3:5. We believe this verse, right? However, what is our tendency when a crisis comes?
6. Discuss the connection between what David is teaching in Psalm 145:13-20 and what Paul said in 2 Corinthians 5:7.
