Life Group Questions

April 9, 2017

1. Jesus was the King of the Jews. Yet, He was not the King the Jews were looking for nor wanted. Why did they not “recognize” and accept Him as King? (Luke 19:10; Matt. 28:20; Luke 24:21)

NOTE: There are 353 Old Testament prophecies fulfilled in Jesus.

2. Do you think we are ever guilty of missing the “real biblical” Jesus and creating our own version of Him like these ancient Jews did? If so, how?
3. How do/would you answer “seekers” when they ask a question like, “I don’t understand how a King could allow himself to be put to death?”
4. What emotions are moved within you when you read the passage from Matthew 27:45-46, “My God, My God, why have you forsaken me?” Also why do you **THINK** there was “darkness over all the land”?
5. Do you believe God **literally** forsook Jesus at the cross? (Matthew 27:46) Why or why not? Use scriptures to support your answer. See Psalm 22.
6. What is the significance for us today concerning Matthew’s statement that “*the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom*”? (Exodus 26:31-37; Hebrews 10:19-23).
7. Through the blood of Jesus at the cross we have the opportunity to be both “reconciled” and “redeemed”. Define both these terms and how did Christ accomplish them? (Eph. 2:16; Romans 5:9; Eph. 2:13; Rom. 3:24; Eph. 1:7).
