Eben's Essentials

What is the most important character trait in marriage? We might mention love, kindness, compassion and loyalty. These are indeed good and useful traits. I was a little surprised when I read the following statement in a recent book by Dr. Chris Thurman: "Humility is the most important character trait in marriage." The more I thought about it, the more I understood why he wrote it. First of all, Godly humility does not refer to weakness. A "namby pamby" person does not equate with a person of Godly humility. In fact, genuine humility can imply strength of character.

How humble it was of Christ to wash his disciples' feet, to listen to them, and most of all to die for all of us on a cross. If we want a healthy marriage, we had better challenge the notion that we are basically good and listen to Romans 3:23 which says that we have all sinned. We should also accept that we are no better or worse than our spouse when compared to Jesus. And finally, it would be wise for us to ask God to help us be humble when we interact with our mate. It's a fact that our marriage will not be healthy and loving if we fail to see the "plank in our own eye" (Luke 6:42), while pointing out the "speck" in our spouse's eye.

We will find enlightenment as we read and heed the words found in 1 Peter 5:5, "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble." We will also profit from Philippians 2:3, which says, "...rather in humility value others above yourselves."
