Richard's Reflections

"Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest!" (John 4:35).

Jesus' mission on earth, by His own admission, was to "seek and save the lost" (Luke 19:10). He was never distracted from that clear objective. He encouraged His disciples in the first century and likewise in the 21st century to follow His lead. Our text above may help us see exactly what Jesus saw and how he felt toward those lost and undone spiritually.

Did you notice from the text the phrase "the fields are already white unto harvest"? Does Jesus have you picturing a field of grain that is matured and ready to harvest? Maybe that's not what He wants us to see. Notice John 4:30, "Then they went out of the city and came to Him." After the woman's testimony, the multitude went to see Jesus. The prevailing color of clothes in that time was white. Dyes to make clothes of a certain color were expensive, so most people could not afford them and so they all wore white. Now picture the "fields white unto harvest" again, but this time picture a mass of white clad souls moving in one accord toward Jesus. Makes a difference doesn't it? We must start looking and loving like Jesus so as to not only sow but to reap a harvest of souls for Him!
