Honduras Update!

In 2017 we raised approximately \$7000.00 specifically to help children in Honduras attend school. The major obstacle to them attending presently is each child must have a school uniform in order to be able to go to school. Well, I have GREAT NEWS!!

We sent \$2,000.00 this week to make 100 school uniforms for those children. We already know of 78 children who will benefit immediately from this first 100 uniforms.

This is a "win-win" for everyone involved. Let me show you why:

1. The material for the uniforms will be purchased at the local markets in Honduras - the material for each uniform will be \$10, this money will help the local economy.
2. There are seven ladies at the Union Church of Christ who have been trained on sewing machines purchased for them by the NW Tampa Church of Christ (this is our partner in the Honduran work). These ladies will be sewing the uniforms for \$10.00 apiece.
3. 78 children will be able to attend school this year who would not/could not if this were not done.
4. The local church in Honduras (Union Church of Christ) will get the "credit" for supplying the uniforms and prayerfully that will bring people to Christ.
5. God will get the glory for it all!!

Also if you're interested in/planning to go to Honduras this year we are going to meet in the teen room immediately after Bible class **NEXT SUNDAY**. The dates for the trip this year are **Monday June 18 – Monday June 25**.

Also for those of you who have asked about the cost of building a home...the cost for this year is \$1400.00 per house. See me or Kim if you have any questions.

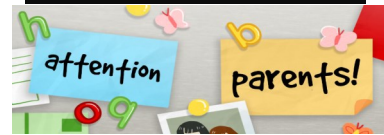
Eben's Essentials

Probably the most popular argument among believers for the existence of God is the design argument. We often hear Christians say that viewing sunrises, sunsets, and other beautiful scenery helps convince them of God. I recently heard a mother say that when she held her firstborn in her arms, she thought of God.

So what does the apparent design in the universe tell us? Christian thinker, Calvin Beisner, has written to help us answer this question. The principle of entropy from the Second Law of Thermodynamics indicates that matter and energy, left to themselves, tend toward maximum disorder. It takes intelligence to bring about order in our material world. When you see a computer, you know it didn't just happen by accident. When the compute functions, you ask who wrote the program and who input the data. The universe has more design in it than any computer. Human brains are better designed and hundreds of times more complex than any computer. Nothing can design itself. That would require it existing before it existed. If it didn't design itself, then its' designer must have sufficient intelligence to account for the design within it. That Intelligent Designer is called God!

Wonders will be about being a light today. We will cover 1 Peter 2:9 which reads,

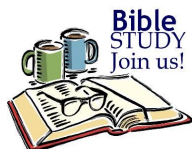
