For the Week of February 11, 2018

1. How does it make you feel to have someone lie to you? So when we are dishonest, do we forget that feeling or do we just think the lies we tell others aren't as bad as the ones told to us?
2. When we read the list of sins from 1 Corinthians 6:9-19, what does it tell us about God's feelings towards lying, dishonesty and cheating?
3. According to our lesson this morning, what is the one stark contrast between God and Satan? (Titus 1:2; Hebrews 6:18; John 8:44).
4. In trying to explain our dishonesty this morning, we stated two reasons; list and discuss both.
5. We mentioned four things to which deceit can bring death. List and discuss each of those. You may discuss others that the group can think of.
6. In the story of Ananias and Sapphira (Acts 5:1-11), their sin was lying – but what other sins contributed to their downfall?
7. Discuss the truth behind the following quote: *"The ripple of today's lie is tomorrow's wave and next year's flood."*
