Eben's Essentials

Jesus, during His earthly ministry, asked many interesting questions. One of the most provocative was: "Who is my mother, and who are my brothers?" (Matthew 12:48)

I read about a youngster reproaching a minister after church one Sunday for referring to his audience as brothers and sisters. The little boy said, "You're not my brother. " The minister responded, "Ah, but I am spiritually your brother because we are all members of God's family."

When Jesus asked about who His mother and brothers were, this had to be confusing to His listeners. After all, His family was standing right outside. His meaning became clearer when He answered His own question: "Whoever does the will of my heavenly Father is my brother, and sister, and mother." He was apparently inviting all of us to be part of His family- one big family of God. Jesus' disciples throughout history - the church -have understood that they were part of a real spiritual family in communion with Him by doing the will of God.

Paul, in Ephesians 5:29, used another figure for God's family when he said that Christians were members of Christ's body, the church. As children of God, we are then the spiritual brothers and sisters of Jesus, one family united in love.
