Folks who want to try out for a sports team or a musical organization prepare themselves by practicing. It's a seemingly thankless task. They won't have cheerleaders to applaud them during a long hard drill. Whether or not they make the team or secure a position in the orchestra, they gain the rewards of perseverance, ability to delay gratification, and enhanced skills.

The same principle can be applied to the things you do for others. "Thank you's" are delayed or missing when you care for the daily needs of an infant. Elderly relatives or patients may forget to express gratitude for services rendered.
