6. What does the word “propitiation” mean and how did the cross of Jesus fulfill it at Calvary?
7. According to 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, what is the gospel? Now read Romans 1:16. What “power” does the gospel contain and how is it activated?
8. Remembering 1 Corinthians 15:1-4, how does a person who believes in Jesus as the Christ join Christ in His death, burial and resurrection? (Romans 6:3-4)
9. Read 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9. Why do you **THINK** there is such a strict punishment for those who do not obey the gospel of Jesus?
