Jesus asked, "What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul?" (Matthew 16:26) In Molière's play, *The Bourgeois Gentleman*, the protagonist, Monsieur Jourdain, pays top dollar for clothes that make him look stylish but awkward. He employs music teachers, a fencing instructor, and a philosophy professor for others to see, rather than for his desire to learn. He wants to be *somebody*. He wants others to consider him important. Yet the more he seeks the appearance of nobility, the more he offends those who really love him, and the more he looks ridiculous to those whom he seeks to impress.

It is appropriate to say that anxiety about social status is a perennial problem. Once we reach a certain level of economic stability, there is no correlation between money and happiness. In fact, several studies have confirmed the link between serving others and overall well-

Jesus' question is so relevant today. He challenges us in Matthew 25 to feed the hungry, provide clothes to the naked, and visit the imprisoned. He also advises us in Luke 22:26 that the greatest are servants. How sad that some of us forfeit happiness, if not our very lives, in our constant pursuit of more.

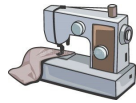
