One of the grandest joys and greatest obligations of life is the role of parenthood. Our children are gifts to us from God. They are our greatest natural resources. Parents who care for the welfare of their children would do well to learn that love involves correction and discipline. Caring for our children involves fair, loving, and consistent discipline.

Parents who care for the welfare of their children must learn that order in a home is a form of love. As parents, we understand that those mothers and fathers who punish their children too harshly increase the generation gap. But I think it is increased also by those who relinquish their role as parents by taking the too easy route of permissiveness. The inspired advice of the Bible is so relevant at this point (Ephesians 6:2-4). The apostle Paul admonishes fathers to not provoke their children to wrath, but in the next breath he says that children should be nurtured in the chastening (i.e., discipline) and admonition (i.e., instruction) of the Lord.

One of the causes of hostility in youth is a lack of shared values with parents. It is unwise to neglect spiritual values in growing together as a family.
