Forgiveness and Me

Jesus said that we are to forgive anyone who sins against us and asks for our forgiveness (Lk. 17:3-4). Refusing to forgive is really not an option if we expect to be forgiven ourselves (Matt. 6:14-15). Every believer is called to imitate God. That means, among other things, that we are to forgive others just as God has forgiven us (Eph. 4:32). As a practical matter, only those who know their own need of forgiveness usually find the grace to forgive others who wrong them. In the same way, the ability to forgive others is strong evidence that the person forgiving has experienced the grace of forgiveness by God.

Even though we forgive another person who wrongs us, the wrongdoer cannot experience and enjoy that forgiveness without acknowledging the wrong done and accepting forgiveness. However, our forgiveness does not depend on the wrongdoer's attitude or conduct. We are to have a heart ready and willing to forgive. We are not to hold grudges or keep account of evil done to us. We had certainly dare not turn anyone away who asks forgiveness for a wrong done to us.

Paul was a real Jew if there ever was one. What's more, he was a member of the Pharisees who demanded the strictest obedience to every Jewish law and custom. But Paul continued on to say that all the things that he once thought very worthwhile, he had now thrown away so he could put his trust and hope in Jesus alone. Everything else was worthless when compared with the priceless gain of knowing Christ Jesus his Lord.

Yes, Paul had put away everything else as worthless when compared with the saving power and abundant life offered by Jesus Christ. In fact, Paul put aside all else, counting it worth less than nothing, in order that he could have Christ, becoming one with him, no longer counting on being saved by being good enough or by perfectly obeying God's laws, but by trusting Jesus and His will for our lives and God's way of making us right with Him.

Paul put it very compellingly when he wrote, "Brothers, I do not consider myself to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: forgetting what is behind and reaching forward to what is ahead, I pursue as my goal the prize promised by God's heavenly call in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:13-14).
