Perhaps the most significant question to ever enter the minds of human beings is, "What think ye of Christ?" Let's ask several people that momentous question.

How did the Pharisees respond?" This man receiveth sinners." What an accusation to make against Jesus! If He had not, what would have become of us? How did Caiphas, the Jewish chief priest, answer the question? "He hath spoken blasphemy," said Caiphas. "He claimed to be God." Now let's ask Pilate. "I find no fault in Him," said Pilate. In fact, Pilate's wife warned him to have nothing to do with that just man because she had a disturbing dream about Him. Nevertheless, Pilate finally conceded to the mob.
