3. What is your favorite part of the story we read this morning from John 13:1-17?
4. What had those whom Jesus called “blessed of my Father” in Matthew 25:34 actually done?
5. What three qualities did we notice from Acts 6:1-7, that were needed to serve in the early church as a deacon (at least a role like unto a deacon)? What do these traits lead you to believe the apostles were looking for in these men?
6. God inspired Paul to list some specific qualities in 1 Timothy 3:8-13 concerning deacons. Briefly list and describe the traits.
7. What does it say to you that although Jesus is the...*Son of God, Messiah, Savior, King of Kings and Lord of Lords*...Paul wrote that when Jesus came to earth He “*emptied Himself and took the form of a servant*”? (Philippians 2:5-8).
