## ***The Jesus Language, #1*** ***Acts of Service***

- Mark 14:36; Matt. 27:46.
- During the month of July we will be talking about the five different love languages which Jesus spoke fluently, and we would be wise to do the same.
- This week we will look at John 13 to learn one of the ways that Jesus showed love to others.

### ***I. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Service (John 13:1-5)***

- Philippians 2:5-11; John 13:1; Matthew 10:42
- When we express love through acts of service, we are giving people a glimpse of Christ. If we want to show people love like Jesus did, we will intentionally serve them.
- By nature, Jesus was a servant! By taking on His nature as a believer I must also be a servant!

### ***II. The \_\_\_\_\_ to Service (John 13:6-11)***

- How many of us have a hard time accepting a washing from Jesus?
- Which do you have a hard time allowing Jesus to do?
  - ***Wash away your \_\_\_\_\_?***
    - Psalm 103:12; Psalm 51
  - ***Wipe away your \_\_\_\_\_?***
    - Psalm 46:1
  - ***Carry your \_\_\_\_\_?***
    - Matthew 11:28-30.
  - ***\_\_\_\_\_ problems?***
    - Matthew 6:25-33
  - ***Love you despite your \_\_\_\_\_?***
    - Romans 3:23; John 3:5.

### ***III. The \_\_\_\_\_ to Service (John 13:12-15, 17)***

- Jesus was solely motivated by love and by a desire to see His disciples serve others, not so they would serve Him in return.
- Romans 5:8; John 13:17; 1 John 3:18; James 2:14-17.

- We may never know how powerful of an impact we can have on someone else until we learn to speak the Jesus language through our acts of service!

8. How damaging to our testimony of Christ is the following statement? *“You can call yourself a follower of Jesus yet deny it with your actions.”*
