Why I Am a Member of the Church of Christ

I have read books which refer to a multiplicity of reasons for being a member of the church of Christ - and yet for the life of me I can still only think of one reason why I am a member of the church of Christ. When I came to learn of the gospel and all the great blessings contained in that message of the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus (1 Cor. 15:1-4); I believed it! I trusted in Christ enough to confess him as Lord and be immersed in water. It was then that God took me, an unworthy human being, and added me to His family (1 Tim. 3:15), His church (Acts 2:47), His body (Eph. 1:22-23). And that is the reason and the **ONLY** reason that I am a member of the church of Christ.

I have not been and am not now a member of God's family because it teaches doctrine A or practices doctrine B. There are, certainly, doctrines and practices of the Bible that I now endeavor to teach and keep - but those things are not the reason I am a member of the church of Christ. The sole reason for my being in God's family is not unlike Paul's reason for being in the ministry, "God placed me" in it (1 Tim 1:12).

I sincerely believe our faith will be built up and our lives strengthened when we simply stand on the fact that the great and sovereign God of heaven made a way for sinful men and women to be part of His family by allowing His own Son to die for our transgressions and upon our trusting that sacrifice placed us into His community of believers here on earth.

It brings me great comfort to know that I am a member of God's household. And that privilege comes not because of what I know or who I know on this earth - but because of God. He gets all the credit...and after all, isn't that how it should be?

Eben's Essentials

Genesis 1:26-28 reveals that mankind was created in God's image. This refers to the fact that God is a person and we are persons. Humans can reveal more of the nature and character of God than trees and stars and other nonpersonal things, which are incapable of revealing the personal characteristics of God.

But human beings as persons have free will, and can willfully choose to reveal their own nature rather than God's nature. The history of the world and of our own lives has more often been the revealing of our own wills rather than the revealing of God's character and will. Fortunately, the Biblical description of the person also includes the possibility of inheriting life from God and becoming related to God as a child is to a parent.

It's necessary that we recognize that as important as the image of God is to an understanding of human beings, it is also vital to understand that, due to sin, human nature is fallen; the original image is marred. But thanks to our loving God, the New Testament description of the person includes the startling idea that God wants to give His spiritual life to human beings as parents give physical life to a child. This teaching about the "new birth" (John 3) means a new life in Christ. This is where the gospel of Jesus Christ comes into play.
