Eben's Essentials

There is a children's story about beavers repairing a break in their dam. The repair had to be completed before nightfall or their lake would drain dry. Their chief realized they would need extra workers if they were to finish before dark. The first group of workers agreed to work all day for six pieces of fresh birch bark. About noon another group of workers arrived to help. The chief said he would pay them what was right and they must hurry in order to finish before dark. As the day progressed, the situation became more desperate. Later that day another group of beavers arrived and were told the same thing. By sundown the dam was finished and the chief gave all the beavers the same salary. Not surprisingly, the early workers began to grumble. The chief reminded them they were paid exactly what they agreed on.

We recognize that this story was based on Christ's parable of three kinds of workers (Matt. 20:1-16). By this parable Jesus taught us about God's amazing mercy and grace. He also taught us that we should serve God with a glad and willing heart and not continually compare ourselves with others. The attitude in which we do our work is very important to God.
