## Richard's Reflections

### What Do I Have to Know?

In 1913, as part of a lengthy article on obedience, David Lipscomb made the following statement: *"There are many results, ends, and promises connected with baptism. A man cannot know and feel all of these. How many must be understood in order to make the baptism acceptable to God? Enough to motivate him to do what is commanded—to be baptized."*

I have been asked many times, by individuals seeking to be faithful to God and His word, the following question, "What do I have to know in order to be baptized?"

My answer to that now is different than what it was twenty-five years ago. Long ago I would've had a list of things a person **MUST** know in order to be scripturally baptized. Now those were all good things and I could give you verses for them. However, although I still think it good for a person to be informed, I now simply ask people if they believe in and trust in the salvation offered and paid for by Jesus. Why? Because like a plant, a Christian is to grow for the duration of their life (2 Peter 3:18; Col. 2:6-7), but like that plant, they must first be planted. And Paul, in Romans 6:5 tells us that we are *"planted together with Christ"* at baptism. So one doesn't have to be a theologian with "all the answers" to be baptized. They simply need to know the One who is the answer...Jesus Christ (John 14:6).

The Bible teaches us that there were people who heard only one sermon and were baptized (Acts 2; Acts 16).

So today...if you believe in Jesus...you can become one of His children—and we would be delighted to help you!!

## Eben's Essentials

One Sabbath as He was teaching in a synagogue, Jesus saw a seriously handicapped woman who had been bent over for many years. Jesus said to her, "Woman, you are healed of your sickness!" He touched her, and instantly she could stand straight. She praised and thanked God. But the local Jewish leader in charge of the synagogue was very angry because Jesus healed her on the Sabbath day. He shouted to the crowd that it was unlawful to work on the Sabbath. But the Savior called him a hypocrite and reminded him that he would untie his cattle from their stalls on the Sabbath and lead them out for water. Christ asked why it would be wrong for Him to free this woman from the bondage of Satan just because it was the Sabbath day. This account is found in the thirteenth chapter of Luke.

The leader who accused Jesus of wrongfully healing on the Sabbath evidently cared more about the Law being broken than he did for the woman. Jesus rebuked this man by calling him a hypocrite for not seeing beyond the Sabbath rules to the needs of a hurting woman. This approach shamed Jesus' adversary, and all the people rejoiced at the wonderful things the Lord did.
