5. Why are many of us fearful of God's will? Why should we not fear God's will? (Romans 8:1; Jeremiah 29:11)
6. Why are we, many times, frustrated with God's will for our lives? (Romans 8:28)
7. Why should we and why does God want us to look at His will with and through faith? (Hebrews 11:6)
8. What are at least two ways (that we mentioned this morning) we can get started in God's will? (1 Timothy 2:3-4; 2 Peter 3:9; Romans 6:3-4; Psalm 119:105)
