Richard's Reflections

"Always"

"Always" isn't easy! Sometimes, occasionally, sporadically...those are easier. But "always" is hard. That's what makes **Colossians 4:6** so difficult. *"Your speech should **always** be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you should answer each person."* Yes, it does say **always**. In the world in which we live I'd take "often" but God wants, "always!"

I don't remember people being as hateful with their speech when they had to literally talk to a person "face to face", as we are now when we can simply shout out hateful, harmful and degrading speech with a tweet or post right from our phones. It's easier to degrade a person when we aren't looking at them or their circumstances. But when we can look at them "from a distance" and attack from that same distance it's easy. So we call people all kinds of names and use horrible and detestable words to do so, all in the name of my "free speech" as an American Citizen. Might I remind you my Christian friend you have a higher calling than the 1st Amendment. **Philippians 3:20** reminds us *"we are **citizens** of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives."*

So the next time you don't agree with the President, NFL players, your kid's teacher/coach, the grocery store clerk, your boss/co-worker, your family/friends...it's ok...just make sure your speech, whether spoken or written is *"**always** seasoned with grace"*.

Eben's Essentials

In one chapter of his 1976 book, Dear Agnos, Pepperdine University history professor, Dr. Arlie J. Hoover, wrote brilliantly on the character of Christ. What follows is a brief summary of what he wrote.

(1) Jesus harmonized strength and tenderness. The strength and courage of Jesus are well documented in the gospels. For example, His criticism of the scribes and pharisees, His indignation when He cleansed the Temple, and His calmness and self-control at His trial. Yet, at the same time, Jesus could be genuinely tender, kind, and generous. (2) Jesus harmonized dignity and humility. For instance, it's beyond human invention for Jesus to make such audacious claims to deity and then stoop down like a servant to wash His disciples' feet. (3) Jesus harmonized piety and approachability. He had that rare ability of being religious without being sanctimonious, of being pure without being self-righteous. He was sinless Himself, but this didn't stop Him from loving and working with all kinds of people. (4) Jesus harmonized self-control and happiness. He showed us that we can be holy without being ascetic, serious without being morose, and happy without being frivolous.

Christ beautifully- exemplified the balanced life. Admiring His traits is like looking through a kaleidoscope: we never seem to run out of patterns to appreciate.
