Deny Yourself!

"Every church is filled with willing people - some willing to work, and others willing to let them."

Selfishness is at the very heart of all our sins. When we consider sinners and the sins they commit we can trace those back to a selfish spirit. Why did Cain kill Abel? Why did the disciples of Christ argue about who would be greatest in the kingdom? Selfishness! That same sin will keep us from serving God and working in His kingdom! However, Jesus doesn't leave us without answers as to how we can conquer self and seek and do His will. Jesus tells us we must **DENY SELF**: ***"Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others"*** (Phil. 2:3-4). Denying self is a pre-requisite to becoming a disciple of Jesus: ***"If any of you wants to be my follower, you must turn from your selfish ways, take up your cross, and follow me"*** (Matthew 16:24). Try to find an occasion in the life of Jesus where He sought His own comfort over others. You won't find one. His life was about denying Himself to the benefit of others. Sometimes we are so consumed with how the world treats "me", how my family treats "me", how the church treats "me", etc. that we lose sight of the fact that God has called us not to focus on self but on the welfare of others. Therefore we are to, ***"Love the Lord your God...and love your neighbor as yourself."***
