Richard's Reflections

Serving Him Because He First Served Us!

Following his washing of the disciple's feet, Jesus said the following, ***"Do you understand what I have just done for you? If I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash each other's feet. I did this as an example so that you should do as I have done for you"*** (John 13:12-15). Jesus plainly says I did this as an example and I want you to do likewise! We are misguided if we think a periodic, literal foot-washing is what He meant. His teaching was much more significant and He is pointing us to a way of life, not just an infrequent act.

These disciples would soon use those freshly washed feet to sprint away from the persecution their Lord would face. Yet no doubt once their heart beat slowed, they would think about their actions and quite literally lower their head in shame, see their feet and remember the love their Lord had for them **AND** the service he rendered to them. Once these men realized all that Jesus had done for them they were never the same, their love increased and their service to Him increased and they managed to *"turn the world upside down"* for Christ (Acts 17:6).

And what about us? Hasn't Jesus done the same for us? Our Savior has washed clean all who have claimed Him as Savior and been buried with Him in baptism (Matthew 10:32; Acts 22:16; Romans 6:1ff). And like the disciples, the love and sacrifice of Jesus for us calls for a response. And there is no greater response to Jesus than ***"doing as He has done for us"***.

Eben's Essentials

One of the most revealing narratives in the New Testament is the story of Peter and Cornelius. According to the tenth chapter of Acts, Peter was given a vision which prepared him to go with three men to the town of Caesarea to converse with a Roman army officer. Cornelius was a devout, God-fearing Gentile who had also been given a vision. He was told to send some men to Joppa and summon a man named Simon Peter. When Peter met Cornelius in Caesarea, he said, "I see very clearly that God shows no favoritism. In every nation He accepts those who fear Him and do what is right." As Peter was speaking, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who were listening. The Jewish believers who came with Peter were amazed that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles, also. Peter taught the Gospel to these Gentiles and they believed and were baptized.

Several very important points are taught in this story. Cornelius was well respected by the Jews even though he was an officer in the Roman occupying army. God reaches out to those who want to know Him. God does not play favorites, and He does not hide from those who want to find Him. Cornelius responded to the Lord and encouraged his family to do the same. This event helped the early church to realize that the Gospel is for all people, both Jews and Gentiles.

It's vital for us to know that the Gospel is for all people. God sent His Son because He loves the whole world - and that includes Peter, Cornelius, and you.
