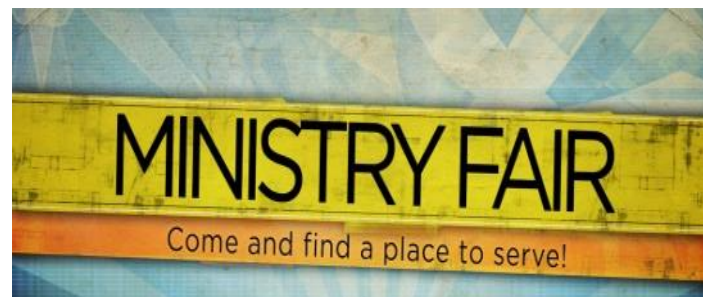

Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be. My Father will honor the one who serves me. John 12:26

I hope you are planning on staying for the ministry fair today. There are so many great ministries here at Westwood that need you. It is going to be a special event! God has called us all to serve him in some way. Even if you think He hasn't He has! There is something that you can do and enjoy doing at Westwood! Don't do something just because no one else has signed up for it if you know that you will not like it. Think about what your passions are and let that help you decide where you might want to serve. I pray that you will come to the ministry fair today eager to find the ministry that you would like to be apart of.

Eben's Essentials

The Bible begins with the statement, "In the beginning God created heaven and earth" (Genesis 1:1). Many scientists used to avoid the idea that the universe (and time itself) had a beginning because it suggested the preexistence of a divine Creator and His intervention in the natural order. Three major theories have been developed to explain the origin of the universe including matter and energy.

One attempt is the "steady-state" model of the universe. It proposes that as the galaxies move farther away from each other, new galaxies are formed in between, out of matter that is being continually created. This implies that the universe could have always existed without a beginning or a creation. One problem is that this theory is merely speculative and violates the truism: "From nothing comes nothing." A second explanation implying matter is eternal is called the "oscillating model." This proposes that the universe expands and contracts indefinitely. All the evidence, however, refutes this position. The universe is clearly losing density with no indication of a reversal of expansion. A third view, which comes closest to matching the Biblical view of creation, is known as the "big bang" theory. Scientific studies have confirmed that all the galaxies are moving apart from us and one another at enormous speeds. Discovery in 1965 of background microwave radiation throughout the universe verifies that all matter was once packed into a dense mass, which suddenly exploded in an enormous flash of light and energy.

As the Bible puts it, "In the beginning You (Lord) laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands" (Psalm 102:25).
