Eben's Essentials

There is nothing more impressive than God's forgiveness. God forgives us over and over. In addition to God's forgiveness, He instructs *us* to forgive and keep forgiving. We can't expect God to forgive us if we aren't willing to forgive others. Jesus said, "Your heavenly father will forgive you if you forgive those who sin against you; but if you refuse to forgive them, He will not forgive you" (Matt. 6:14-15).

God, in the Old Testament, is still a God of mercy and forgiveness. When we read the seventh chapter of Micah, we find that there is no deity like God who pardons the sins of His people and who cannot stay angry with His people, for He loves to be merciful. In the first chapter of the New Testament book of I John, we learn that God is light and has no darkness in Him at all. If we are living in the light of God's presence as Christ does, then we have wonderful fellowship and joy with each other, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from every sin. We also learn that to claim we have not sinned is a lie, but thank God, Christ died to wash away our sins. After we've confessed our sins to God, repented of them, and forgiven those who have sinned against us, we can rest in the truth that He delights in forgiving us.

Grace is best defined by the words undeserved favor. There is nothing we have done or can do to deserve God's grace. We can't work for it or buy it. What a gift!
