Living in the Light: Lessons from 1 John ***1 John 1 – Continuing in the Light***

***Life Group Questions for the Week Beginning...
Sunday January 13, 2019***

1. This may be hard to admit for some of us...but might you be a little afraid of the dark? Why?
2. What are some reasons to be very afraid of the dark, spiritually speaking? (John 3:19; Col. 1:13; Eph. 6:10-13).
3. What “testimony” should each of us as Christians be able to share with others? (1 John 1:3; John 20:29).
4. How does one have fellowship with God? What does that entail? (1 John 1:6; John 8:12; 1 John 2:9-11)
5. What blessings do you see taught in 1 John 1:7? What do these mean to you personally?
6. Does 1 John 1:7 teach that we can know “without a doubt” we are going to heaven? Why? Why not? (See also John 10:25-30; 1 John 5:13).
7. With spiritual maturity comes the desire to sin less – however, what does 1 John 1:8-10 teach us about this?
