Eben's Essentials

We have an excellent role model in Joseph, the son of Jacob. Joseph's brothers sold him into slavery. He ended up – through the providence of God – as second in command in Egypt only to Pharaoh himself. Because of a famine in their land, Jacob sent Joseph's brothers to Egypt to buy food. They didn't recognize the Egyptian official they were dealing with as their brother. Joseph eventually identified himself, and Jacob and his household moved to Egypt. Joseph was now in charge.

Genesis 50 tells us that many years later, after burying Jacob back in his homeland, Joseph and his brothers returned to Egypt. Now that their father was dead, the brothers were terrified that Joseph would show his anger and pay them back for the wrong they did him. Joseph responded, "Don't be afraid of me. Am I God, that I can punish you? You intended to harm me, but God intended it all for good."

Joseph never used his power to take revenge on his brothers. He solidly closed the book on what they did to him in the past. He started over with them. Joseph had tasted God's mercy and he was consequently able to show mercy to others.
