Richard's Reflections

Giving Credit to Jesus!

Think about this - when a person in our church becomes a Christian, how do we describe this? What words do we use? Usually we say they were baptized. They will tell others, "I was baptized." Now baptism is good and right - but doesn't it seem like we are saying that my decision and my actions determined my salvation? Folks in the first century did not point back to their baptism when contemplating their salvation...they went back to the cross and gave credit where credit is due. *"At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures...But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, He saved us, not because of righteous things we have done, but because of His mercy"* (Titus 3:3-5). They were taught that one is *"saved by grace through faith and that not of yourselves it is the gift of God not by works lest any man should boast"* (Eph. 2:8-9).

Even when reminded about their baptism, first century Christians were told that they were *"baptized into Christ Jesus"*, *"baptized into His death"* and *"united with Him"* (Romans 6:3-5).

Being saved is a wonderful blessing but as saved people let's be sure that others know that we have contributed nothing to our salvation and see that others understand that **Jesus Paid it ALL!**

Eben's Essentials

When our son lived in Lexington, KY, we travelled the back roads on the way to see him. We passed by a little Kentucky town named Monticello. We noticed a sign advertising the Wayne County Museum in Monticello. We decided one day to stop and visit. There we found a wealth of information about the famed Restoration Movement preacher, "Raccoon" John Smith. We also visited the historic First Christian Church building in town. The minister graciously showed us around and answered our questions. Across the street we viewed the small, rustic cabin, which was built by "Raccoon" John Smith, before 1814, on his farm 14 miles away, and moved to its present site in 1972.

"Raccoon" grew up as a strict Calvinist believing one must receive a miraculous sign indicating that one is among the predetermined saved elect. As an adult, from studying the New Testament, Smith became convinced that *free will* triggers the response to become a Christian.

John Smith was born in 1784 and died in 1868. He was a witty, physically strong, largely self-educated man. He studied the Bible constantly. As a horseback-riding parson, he often preached twice a day and brought people into the kingdom of Christ by the hundreds everywhere he went. His plan was to simply state what the Bible said. He aimed to draw no deductions of opinions, or if he did, he would label them as opinions, and not impose them as tests of fellowship.
