Overcoming Distractions, #3

In our study of Nehemiah, have you noticed what the characters Sanballat, Tobiah, and Geshem do for good? **NOTHING!!** Sure, they criticize, find fault, write letters of criticism (based on rumors) but nothing they do accounts for good. And if you will take a minute and think of the most critical people you know, you will also see the same truth about them. People who are **not** actively involved in **doing good** for the cause of Christ will be in the business of criticizing others. Remember the problem Paul wrote about in 2 Thessalonians 3? It was the problem of the idle not working and being busy bodies. Their hands were not busy - but their mouths were working overtime!

Nehemiah's keys to overcoming the distraction of the idle were rather simple. He told them the work in which he was engaged was too important to stop for the "*inventions*" of idle minds (Neh. 6:8). And how did he deal with the critical letter writers? He simply prayed and said, "**O God, strengthen our hands**" (Neh. 6:9). Strengthen their hands for what? The work which was being done for the glory of God! Paul encourages us to do the same thing in Gal. 6:9? "**Do not grow weary in doing well!!**"

Eben's Essentials

We see it more and more these days. Secularists, skeptics and others hostile to Christianity claim that Jesus never really rose from the dead. They say that the whole Christian faith is a sham.

What is the evidence for the truth of the resurrection of Jesus? Ancient prophecies predicted the resurrection of the Messiah. All four gospels written by four separate authors agree on the same story, and they included eyewitnesses to the event. Other witnesses over several days' time, including women, attested to seeing both an empty tomb and the resurrected Christ. If this story were legend, Jewish writers would certainly not have included the testimony of women. The ongoing testimony of the disciples themselves is impressive, especially in the face of execution. Perhaps the most precious evidence of all is summed up in this line from a familiar hymn by Alfred H. Ackley "You ask me how I know He lives - He lives within my heart!"

Your thoughts are directed toward a passage from the New Testament: "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead (1 Peter 1:3).
