Eben's Essentials

We are so made by God as to have needs in life. We know what our physical needs are: hunger, thirst, sex, etc. Our emotional, psychological and spiritual needs are just as compelling. I believe our basic personal needs are significance and emotional security as the basis for self-worth. Every person is compelled to try to meet these needs. *How* we try to meet them is determined primarily by our ideas (beliefs) about what it takes to be a worthwhile person (significant and secure). Unfortunately, most of us tell ourselves some pretty foolish things about how to meet our personal needs. Often, our worldly, unbiblical, irrational beliefs deny us the true satisfaction of our deep personal needs.

I'll just mention three out of many. (1) "Money makes a person important (significant)." (2) "Sex is the route to personal fulfillment and joy." (3) "Having things go as I want is essential to my happiness." The third is perhaps the most deceptive and subtle of the three.

Since God created us in His image, He knows what is best for us. It is only by "getting in tune" with Him that we can fully satisfy our needs and become the whole person that God wants us to be. It would be good to regularly heed the admonition of Philippians 4:8.
