## Eben's Essentials

Perhaps, as some have suggested, fear is the root negative emotion. Since "God is love" and has made us in His own image, the root positive emotion is love. Therefore, the soundest advice I can give you is to let go of fear and embrace love. If we let go of fear, then only love remains, for love is what we are.

A temptation to resist is the tendency to compare ourselves with others. This is especially tempting to those of us who feel a little insecure about ourselves and who experience a corresponding lack of self-confidence. Marcus Aurelius, the Roman Emperor and Stoic Philosopher, wrote: "How much trouble he avoids who does not look to see what his neighbor says, or does or thinks, but only to what he does himself, that it may be just and pure."

A habit to avoid is the habit of being overly critical toward others. Our Lord's illustration of the fellow with a log in his eye trying to get a speck out of his neighbor's eye hits the nail on the head (Matt. 7:1-3). Habitual faultfinding usually has its source in feelings of uneasiness and a lack of self-confidence on the part of the faultfinder. It's so easy to acquire because it is so common in society. Let's try to make the "Golden Rule" our guiding principle: "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you" (Matt. 7:12).
