James Dobson read the following on Focus on Family Radio - a letter from an 80 year old woman on Mother's Day.

To all my children: I suppose this year's Mother's Day started my thoughts along these lines...This is a good time to tell you that what I truly want are things I can never get enough of, yet they are free. I want the intangibles. I would like for you to come and sit with me, and for you to be relaxed. We can talk, or we can be silent. I would just like for us to be together. I need your patience when I don't hear what you say the first time. I know how tiresome it is to always be repeating, but sometimes I must ask you to repeat. I need your patience when I think too much about the past, with my slowness and my set ways. I want you to be tolerant with what the years have done to me physically. Please be understanding about my personal care habits. I spill things. I lose things. I get unduly excited when I try to figure out my bank statements. I can't remember what time to take my medication, or if I took it already. I take too many naps. Sometimes sleep helps to pass the day.

*Well, there you have it: **Time, Patience, and Understanding.** Those are priceless gifts that I want. Paul said, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." I know I can, too! It's a wonderful feeling to know God's eye is on the sparrow and I know He cares for me. I guess being old isn't so bad after all!*

Many of us allow ourselves to fall into the habit of worrying. We spoil, to some extent, our precious present moments by this unfortunate habit. Habitual worry comes from fear and anxiety. They come partially from mentally "catastrophizing frustrations." Frustrations are simply a part of life. We live in a fallen world. Concern about them is understandable. What is to be avoided is over concern. When we "awfulize" in our thoughts about the unpleasant things that happen to us, worry becomes a bothersome part of our lives. Guilt feelings over what has happened in our past and worry over what might happen in our future are unnecessary and self-defeating. Learning from our past experiences and planning for the future do not mean that we have to live guiltily and painfully in the past or fearfully in the future. The present moment is God's gift to us.

When we tell ourselves that something is "awful" or "terrible," we probably mean that to us it is unendurable. In reality, things may be "unfortunate," "unpleasant," "sad," or "painful," but not more than we can endure. As Christians, we have God's help on which to rely.

Jesus said, "Do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself" (Matt. 6:34).
