## Eben's Essentials

When the sun goes down, many of us have restless thoughts about what might happen. This can rob us of tonight's sleep and tomorrow's strength. Worry is an expression of our fear of the future. It has been around since the Garden of Eden. Worry is a feeling of uneasiness, apprehension or dread usually related to negative thoughts of something that may happen in the future. Worry defeats us when it replaces wise action or needed rest with fearful emotion.

Christians are not immune to worry or its complications. We want so much to exert a positive influence on our family, friends, and co-workers as they see us trusting in the goodness of God. Worry and anxiety may lead us to feel we are letting them down. Not surprisingly, many high achievers are worriers, driven not only by a desire to succeed but also by a fear of failure. Most of us know what it is to face situations that make us uneasy, even panicky. Some of us lie awake at night thinking about the fate of a son or daughter. Others worry about job situations or health or a family that is falling apart.

Catherine Marshal said that the greatest discovery we can make is to realize that our own strength is not enough. King David knew God's goodness and love by experience. That's why he could write that even in the darkest valleys of life, he feared no evil (Psalm 23:4). God shows us four disciplines that lead us to wholeness: read, pray, trust, and obey. Jesus said, "Do not worry about your life" (Matthew 6:25). And Paul wrote, "Be anxious for nothing" (Philippians 4:6).
