Not that I desire your gifts; what I desire is that more be credited to your account."*

## Eben's Essentials

Extreme anger is so destructive of human relationships and so self-destructive. The outward rage and the inward resentment are both so very harmful. I want to share with you some insights I have acquired through the years.

First, it helps to understand the roots of anger – where it comes from. Like most emotional reactions, it comes from our thoughts. These come from our basic assumptions or beliefs about how we can meet our personal needs of significance and emotional security as the basis of self-worth. It seems to me that perhaps the prime belief that motivates the thoughts that generate frustration and anger is: "Having things go as I want is essential to my happiness." This belief leads us to mentally demand that people and life behave nicely and fairly toward us. We naturally desire that people and life treat us well, but when we mentally convert this healthy want into an unhealthy demand or need, excessive frustration and anger are the products.

One way to begin to defeat excessive anger is to persistently challenge the false basic assumptions or beliefs at the root of the problem. "It is not necessary that things go as I want in order for me to be happy." "It is merely unfortunate not awful that this injustice or frustration happened." Eph.4:26 advises us "to not let the sun go down on our anger."
