## Richard's Reflections

### Ephesus

The church at Ephesus was "straight as a gun barrel doctrinally" and just as "empty as a gun barrel spiritually". They were extra careful to be doctrinally pure but had fallen out of love with the Lord Jesus Christ. Do we realize such can happen today as well? We can be focused on sound doctrine, but in the process leave our first love and fall away from Christ.

It could be said of the church at Ephesus that they had "dotted the i's and crossed the t's" but their zeal was gone. There are churches like that in existence today. Some are doctrinally straight as an arrow, but their services are dead and cold. On the other hand, there are some who have emotionally charged services, and yet have little or no concern for whether or not their deeds are scriptural. We need both! We need zeal, we need to be excited about where we are in Christ and what He is doing in us. But that must also be balanced with healthy teaching and a deep abiding respect for the word of God.

It is extremely sad that back in Acts 19:1-20 we read of how joyously the Ephesians had received the Lord - but now had let their fire for him be extinguished.

Let's be careful not to let that happen in our life and in our church.

## Eben's Essentials

The practice of self-control is an enterprise well worth cultivating. As a matter of fact, for the Christian, it is indispensable. The basic false belief (misbelief) behind poor self-control is probably the idea that we should have everything we want. In fact, mentally turning our desire for something into a demanding need for it may lie at the heart of the problem. The devil has managed to convince millions of people that they can't exercise self-control. As long as a person continues to believe this lie, it will cause itself to become reality. We control our feelings and behaviors by our beliefs and thinking.

It's good to learn to disconnect the triggers that set off the behaviors you don't want. For example, if you're trying to maintain mastery over the sin of lust, don't allow yourself to be in places of temptation with persons of the opposite sex. If you're trying to lose weight, don't keep candy in your cabinet. Don't carry your credit cards when you go shopping if you're a compulsive buyer. Learn to avoid the situations and disconnect the triggers that set off the behaviors you don't want.

The idea of "once-fail-always fail" is total fiction. Hebrews 12:2 tells us to "fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith." Jesus helps us to be the people we were meant to be. In matters of money, sex, speech, and in the proper use of our time and energy, through the Lord we can learn to exercise self-control.
