Richard's Reflections

Selfish Salvation?

We live in a selfish world and the main reason is because we are selfish people! A selfish, "look out for number one" attitude is dangerous when dealing with our families, our jobs and our friends, but it can be deadly when we begin to take credit for our spiritual success.

Think about it - when a person in our church becomes a Christian, how do we describe this? What words do we use? Usually we say they were baptized. They will tell others, "I was baptized." Now baptism is good and right - but doesn't it seem like we are saying that my decision and my actions determined my salvation? Folks in the first century did not point back to their baptism when contemplating their salvation...**they went back to the cross** and gave credit where credit is due. *"At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived...But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, He saved us, not because of righteous things we have done, but because of His mercy"* (Titus 3:3-5). They were taught that one is *"saved by grace through faith and that not of yourselves it is the gift of God not by works lest any man should boast"* (Eph. 2:8-9).

Even when reminded about their baptism, early Christians were told that they were *"baptized into Christ Jesus", "baptized into His death" and "united with Him"* (Romans 6:3-5).

Being saved is a wonderful blessing but as saved people let's be sure that others know that we have contributed nothing to our salvation and see that others understand that **Jesus Paid it ALL!**

Eben's Essentials

Your reflection appears when you look into a mirror. You may find some flaws glaring at you. A similar experience may occur when you step in front of the mirror of life. You may notice some weaknesses and think, "I can't" or more hopefully, "I have some interesting challenges ahead." It depends on you, your attitude, and your faith in Jesus.

Can you remember first donning a pair of polarized sunglasses? Cutting down on glare gave objects clarity and made colors more vivid. Being Christians, the internal lens of our mind, or what we believe, impacts how we live and who we become. In Romans 12:2 we are advised, "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." If you see the Lord as personal and involved in your life, you will experience more joy. If you believe in personal stewardship, that everything you are and own belong to God, you will more willingly help others. If you see people as God sees them (of infinite value and worth), you will become more gentle and loving toward them.

Jesus wants to give us new internal lenses by transforming our minds. He does this as we grow in our desire to more firmly establish ourselves in what we believe. We are aided immensely in this endeavor by the benediction found in II Cor. 13:14, "May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."

Karley's Kids

This Week's Gospel Project lesson is:

Unit 12, Session 2: Wisdom for God's People

"Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, and Song of Songs are three books spanning more than 50 chapters of the Bible. This week's study follows the story of Solomon, the primary writer of these books. While three books of the Bible are certainly a lot to cover in one session, this brief overview will reveal the wisdom of God for His people as He works out His wise plan for our salvation.

True wisdom comes from God. (See Prov. 2:6.) God made Solomon the wisest man who had ever lived, and people came from all over to listen to his wisdom. (See 1 Kings 4:29-34; 10:1-9.) He wrote most of the Book of Proverbs, which offers practical advice for living wisely. Solomon ruled Israel with great wisdom, but he still turned away from God and pursued His own desires.

Israel needed someone greater than Solomon. God's plan included that: "Something greater than Solomon is here!" (Matt. 12:42; Luke 11:31). Jesus not only taught God's wisdom, He displayed it perfectly.

Wisdom in the Bible shows us how to be like Jesus—in how we live, how we speak, and how we think. But wisdom cannot save us. Only Jesus, who perfectly followed God's wise plan, can rescue us from sin."
