Eben's Essentials

In Psalm 72, the psalmist was praying for the king to be compassionate as he ruled. Here is the prayer as recorded in Psalm 72:1-2, "Endow the king with your justice, O God, the royal son with your righteousness. May he judge your people in righteousness, your afflicted ones with justice." In verse 4, the psalmist's request became more specific: "May the king defend the afflicted among the people and save the children of the needy." Note that the psalmist directed his petition to the source of all compassion, almighty God.

For many of us, compassion doesn't come naturally. We have a tendency to be self-centered individuals who can be oblivious to other people's needs and hurts. If we do notice their pain and suffering, we may be too busy or self-absorbed to help in any meaningful way.

Fortunately, God, the Holy Spirit, can change our hearts and make us more like Jesus. We can become more compassionate in thought, word, and deed. Thankfully, Westwood has many programs that can aid us in becoming more involved in compassionate activities. Within our own sphere of everyday family and community life there are many opportunities. I think we can all agree that God calls all Christians to show compassion to people in need.
