Jesus and Balance

There remains a constant need for disciples of Christ to seek for balance in all that we do. Love for God must be expressed by love for others (Matt. 22:37-39). Love for truth must be expressed with the mind and disposition of Him who is the Truth (John 14:26; Phil. 2:5). If we courageously stand for everything that is good and right, even to the point of sacrificing our very lives on the martyr's altar, it all amounts to nothing if we are not motivated by love (1 Cor. 13).

Balance is vitally important to Christian living. The only true way to avoid extremes is to make each decision, and chart each spiritual course, with but one view in mind: ***Where is Jesus in all of this?*** When we study the Bible with "Jesus-colored" glasses, we will avoid much inconsistency in the way we apply Biblical principles on a practical level. When we ask, "What would Jesus do in this situation?" We clearly **CANNOT** go wrong.

Unfortunately, all through life we may find some people talking about us and saying cruel things about us. This is particularly so in our youth. Older people, to some extent, are not quite so prone to do this although people of all ages, sadly, have a tendency to talk about others in an uncomplimentary way. It can be extremely painful, especially when we are young and trying to form a self-image, to have individuals call us untrue, ugly names and say unfair things about us. It can motivate us to reply in kind and to even become hard and bitter. And/or it can lead us to have self-doubts about our worth and value as a person. Either response can and should be avoided. Many of us are very concerned about youth suicides and the problem of bullying. What is a proper response?

First of all, we should recognize the fact that what they said about us (mean and unfair as it was) did not upset us. Rather, we upset ourselves by our mental evaluation of what they said; by what we told ourselves in our minds about what they said. If I become unduly bothered and anxious at someone's expressed opinion of me, I'm making myself unhappy by convincing myself that what someone else thinks is more important than what I and my friends think. Second, our critics have their own troubles, problems and needs they are struggling to cope with. Often people project on others the doubts and fears they have about themselves.
