## Eben's Essentials

The Biblical book of Proverbs has so much good advice for us. For instance, "The man of integrity walks securely; but he who takes crooked paths will be found out" (Proverbs 10:9). The Old Testament figure, Job, seemed to have it all – a large family, many servants, large herds, and much land. He also lived a blameless and upright life before God. God blessed him. But suddenly, he lost it all. Job's wife urged Job to "curse God and die!" At that point, she saw no value in following God. He appeared to have abandoned them for no good reason.

If you were Job, what would you do? Would you say to yourself, "It looks like I made a mistake. Next time, I'll scratch my way to the top by hook or crook. I'll succeed any way I can"? Or would you say like Job did, "The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away; may the name of the Lord be praised" (Job 1:21)? Our integrity and the quality of our faith are often called on to stand the test. Incidentally, Job remained faithful and upright, and the second half of his life was even better than the first.

Here's the challenge we all face. The world says: "You have to bend the rules to get ahead." God says: "Nothing really good will be withheld from those who walk in integrity."

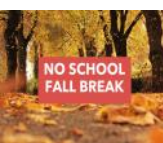
