Eben's Essentials

The third enemy of inner peace in our series of articles is *narcissism*. In Greek mythology, a beautiful youth named Narcissus fell in love with his own reflection in a fountain. When a person becomes infatuated by and obsessed with his or her own personality and/or appearance, internal war is the consequence. A renowned psychologist has said that the two greatest impediments to a healthy human personality are vanity and pride. A recipe for being miserable is to be self-obsessed, talk continually about oneself, and demand attention and appreciation from others. It's probably not well recognized that personal insecurity is at the root of much human arrogance.

Paul was striking at the heart of the temptation to be narcissistic when he wrote, "For I say, through the grace that was given to me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but so to think as to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to each man a measure of faith" (Romans 12:3).

We rightly overlook psychiatric patients who see themselves as world-renowned characters. However, we may miss the fact that there are millions of persons outside hospitals who are suffering from narcissus conceit. Paul declared that "love vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up" (1 Cor. 13:4).
