1. Read Jeremiah 18:1-6. What is the historical context and (generally) how can we today apply this passage to our lives?
2. In what three ways is God the “Potter” in our lives? (Job 10:8-9; John 3:3-5; 2 Cor. 5:17)
3. What is one thing we must all do to find rest and peace from our heartbreak and troubles in this life? (Jer. 18:1; Matthew 11:28-30; Isaiah 55:1,6)
4. What is the main point of Jeremiah 18:4; Psalm 115:3; Romans 9:20-21; 1 John 3:20; Psalm 147:5)? Why is it so hard for us to let God do this?
5. List and discuss the four points we studied concerning how God heals our broken hearts from Romans 8:28.

## SERMON OUTLINE & NOTES

### God Can Heal Your Broken Heart

- There are many here and in our world who have broken hearts (2 Timothy 3:12; Matthew 7:24-27).
- No matter the source of the heartache and emotional pain, the path to healing that we will discuss today is both clear and filled with a promise from God!
- Our text today is **Jeremiah 18:1-6**.

### The \_\_\_\_\_ to the Potter

- **Jeremiah 18:1-3**
- He is the Potter because he made us \_\_\_\_\_ (Job 10:8-9).
- He is the Potter because He gives new life \_\_\_\_\_ (John 3:3; 2 Cor. 5:17)
- God also renews us \_\_\_\_\_ (Matt. 1:23; Heb. 4:15; John 11:35; Luke 19:41-42)
- But in order to allow God to do that which He longs to do in your life and mine, we must make the trip to the Potter's House (Matt. 11:28-30; Isaiah 55)

### The \_\_\_\_\_ to the Potter

- **Jeremiah 18:4**
- The point here is that the Potter does what he pleases with the clay (Psalm 115:3).
- We need to stop telling God how to do His job (Rom. 9:20-21; 1 John 3:20; Psalm 147:5)

### The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Potter

- **Jeremiah 18:5-6**
- Let's examine **Romans 8:28**.
- The Potter's Job is \_\_\_\_\_: "And we **KNOW**..."
- The Potter's Job is \_\_\_\_\_: "**ALL** things..."
- The Potter's Job is \_\_\_\_\_: "**Work TOGETHER**..."
- The Potter's Job is \_\_\_\_\_: "**For GOOD**..."
